ITHACA FESTIVAL

June 1 - 3. A weekend music and arts celebration, featuring over 1,000 local musicians, painters, dancers, clowns, and ensembles. **Downtown.**

CFCU SUMMER CONCERT SERIES

June 21- Sept 6. A free outdoor concert series open to the public, every Thursday at the Bernie Milton Pavilion (or The Range in case of rain.) **Downtown.**

CORNELL FRIDAY CONCERTS

June 29 - August 3. Free concert series hosted by the School of Continuing Education & Summer Sessions – “take a chance and experience something new.” **Cornell.**

INDEPENDENCE DAY FIREWORKS

July 3. Hosted by the Ithaca Rotary Club at Stewart Park; free and open to the public, arrive early to get a good spot! **Waterfront.**

TAUGHANNOCK SUMMER CONCERTS

July 7 - August 25. Held at Taughannock Falls State Park, concerts start at 7:00pm and usually last about two hours. \$5 fee for parking. **TCAT Route 22.**

DRAGON BOAT FESTIVAL

July 14. Held at Taughannock Falls State Park, this event celebrates Asian and Asian-American cultures and heritage through dragon boat racing and festival activities. **TCAT Route 22.**

GRASSROOTS FESTIVAL

July 19 - 22. Over 80 bands performing across four stages over four days at the Trumansburg Fairgrounds – a must-see for music lovers. Day passes start at \$49. **TCAT Route 21**

MOVIES IN THE PARK

August 3 - 31. Every Friday at dusk throughout August; free and open to the public, featuring family-friendly movies and local food vendors at Stewart Park. **Waterfront.**
